

Septic System Transfer Inspectors in Arizona

ACC R18-9-A316 requires a Transfer Inspector to meet the following qualifications:

1. Possesses working knowledge of the type of facility and the inspection process; AND
2. Hold a certificate of training from a course recognized by the Department as sufficiently covering the information specified in the Section; AND
3. Holds a license in one of the following categories:
 - a. An Arizona registered engineer;
 - b. An Arizona Registered sanitarian;
 - c. An owner of a vehicle with a human excreta collection and transport license under 18 ACC, Article 11 or an employee of the owner of the vehicle;
 - d. A contractor licensed by the Registrar of Contractors in one of the following categories:
 - i. Residential Licenses B-4 or C-41;
 - ii. Commercial Licenses A, A-12, or L-41, or
 - iii. Dual Licenses KA or K-41;
 - iv. A wastewater treatment plant operator certified un 18 AAC 5, Article 1; or
 - v. A person qualifying under another category designated by the Department.
